Certified Electrolysis Program

Program Description

The curriculum for students enrolled in the Certified Electrolysis Program consists of 600 hours. The theoretical portion is via distance education which consists of 250 hours. The practical portion will be in person with hands-on instruction that consists of 350 hours. Theoretical instruction refers to instruction by online lecture, bookwork and examination. Practical training (hands-on) is the time to learn and practice the art of electrolysis. The practical portion is to be completed at Utah School of Hair Removal main campus located at 1266 S Legend Hills Dr STE B4, Clearfield, Utah 84015. It is required that the student finish the online and textbook study prior to the start of the hands-on portion of the training.

The Utah School of Hair Removal (*may be referred to as USHR or school throughout the document*) contains the Certified Electrolysis Program specifically designed for Electrolysis. Training received will prepare students to become Electrologists eligible to become certified once the Utah State Boards are satisfied. After completing this program, you will be proficient in using state of the art equipment and be able to meet the demands of industry. Check the catalog for the scheduled start dates. The Certified Electrolysis Program must be completed within 1 year of enrollment.

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Equipment and IT Requirements for Distance Education

The student will need to have a computer, laptop or tablet, and access to high speed internet. In addition, the student must have the ability to open the theoretical portion through the link provided and have access to a webcam or smartphone with Zoom capabilities. You may use one of the following browsers in their latest publicly released version: Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Apple Safari, Microsoft Edge.

Admission Requirements

- Applicants must provide valid proof of identification. (government issued photo identification)
- Applicants must be at least 17 years of age. If a student is currently enrolled in high school, transcripts with passing grades and parental permission is required. Prior to enrollment, USHR will seek a training agreement with the student's school district. Otherwise, a completed high school transcript, a high school diploma, or the equivalent GED is required as prescribed by Utah law. (See Rule 152-34-4 (3) of the Utah Administrative Code.
- Applicants must fill out the Enrollment Agreement, Disclosure Statement, Distance Education Self Assessment Form, and pay the deposit of \$1,500 and non-refundable \$100.00 Application Fee.
- Applicants must have a good working knowledge of English, both reading and writing.
- Applicants with a foreign high school diploma: the translation and evaluation of the credential must be performed by an outside agency that is qualified to translate documents into English and confirm the academic equivalence to a U.S. high school diploma.
- Students who were previously enrolled but have withdrawn from the program can re-enroll based on administrative approval. Applicants must start the enrollment process over and pay all associated fees applied to a new applicant.

Graduation Requirements

In order to be considered for graduation, students completing the Certified Electrolysis Program must successfully complete the following:

- Attain 600 or more clock hours and satisfy the minimum hours required.
- Successfully pass all quizzes and exams with a score of 75% or more.
- Successfully pass the written final exam and practical final exam with a 75% or more.
- Attain 250 theoretical hours and 350 practical hours.
- Must have all financial obligations to school met, unless a finance agreement has been made. Students will be provided with a "Certificate of Completion" and "Verification of Graduation" which will enable them to take the Utah State Board exams.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Student's Right to Cancel

The student has the right to cancel and obtain a full refund of charges paid until midnight of the third business day after the latest of the following days. Official cancellation or withdrawal shall occur on the earlier of the dates that:

1. The day the student signs an enrollment agreement;
2. The day the student pays USHR and initial deposit or first payment toward tuition and fees; or
3. The day that the student first visits the USHR and before the student receives access to the online theoretical portion.

For applicants who cancel enrollment or students who withdraw from enrollment, a fair and equitable settlement will apply. The following policy will apply to all terminations for any reason, by either party, including student decision, program cancellation, or school closure.

The refund excludes the \$100 non-refundable Application Fee and, if received, the Business Starter Kit including tax. The notice of cancellation shall be in writing and submitted directly to Utah School of Hair Removal.

Students beginning the distance education portion of their training shall have the right to cancel the agreement and receive a full refund before the first lesson and material are received. Cancellations are effective on the date the written notice of cancellation is sent. If the student has received any materials, not including Business Starter Kit, before an effective cancellation notice was received, USHR shall make a refund within 45 days after the student's return of the materials.

Other Cancellations: An application requesting cancellation more than three (3) days after executing the enrollment agreement and making an initial payment, but prior to receiving access to the online theoretical portion is entitled to a refund of all monies paid, less the non-refundable application fee, and a maximum tuition fee of 15% of the stated cost of the program. Refer to catalog for detailed information.

Refund Policy

After the cancellation period, USHR provides a pro rate refund of ALL funds paid for tuition charges to students who have completed 50 percent or less of the period of attendance. The refund is calculated based upon the student's last date of attendance. Once 50 percent of the enrollment period in the entire program has been incurred (including absences), there will be no refund to the student.

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The application fee of \$100.00 is a non-refundable item. Business Starter Kit and any other items issued and received by the student are not returnable or refundable. Once received by the student, it will belong to the student and will represent a liability to the student.

If you cancel the agreement, the school will refund any money that you paid, less any deduction for Application Fee and equipment received. If you withdraw from USHR after the cancellation period, the refund policy described above will apply. If the amount that you have paid is more than the amount that you owe for the time you scheduled, then a refund will be made within 45 calendar days of the official withdrawal. See Refunds section below. If the amount that you owe is more than the amount that you have already paid, then you will have to arrange to pay it within 30 days. Official withdrawal date is on the student's notification or school's determination.

If an applicant is not accepted by the school, the applicant shall be entitled to a refund of all monies paid, except a non-refundable application fee of \$100.

See Refunds section below. If the amount that you owe is more than the amount that you have already paid, then you will have to arrange to pay it within 30 days.

Official withdrawal date is on the student's notification or USHR's determination. A student can be expelled if the student fails to comply with any of USHR's policies. Unofficial withdrawals will be determined by USHR by monitoring attendance at least every 30 days. In the case of disabling illness or injury, death in the student's immediate family or other documented mitigating circumstances, a reasonable and fair refund settlement will be made.

USHR does not participate in state or federal financial aid programs at this time. If a student obtains a loan to pay for an educational program, the student will have to repay the full amount of the loan plus interest, less the amount of any refund, and that, if the student receives federal financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of the monies not paid from federal financial aid funds. Should the student complete the program earlier than the estimated time frame stated in the contract, the student's financial aid package may be recalculated and this may result in liabilities owed by the student if applicable.

If the student receives federal student aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of monies not paid from federal student financial aid program funds. If the student obtains a loan to pay for an educational program, the student will have the responsibility to repay the full amount of the loan plus interest, less the amount of any refund.

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If the student is eligible for a loan guaranteed by the federal or state government and the student defaults on the loan, both of the following may occur;

1. The federal or state government or a loan guarantee agency may take action against the student, including applying any income tax refund to which the person is entitled to reduce the balance owed on the loan.
2. The student may not be eligible for any other federal student financial aid at another institution or other government financial assistance until the loan is repaid.

Withdrawal Procedure

A student choosing to withdraw from the school after the commencement of classes is to provide a written notice to USHR. The notice must include the expected last date of attendance and be signed and dated by the student.

If special circumstances arise, a student may request, in writing, a leave of absence, which should include the date the student anticipates the leave beginning and ending. The withdrawal date shall be the earlier of the date the student is scheduled to return from a leave of absence or the date the student notifies USHR that they are not returning and completes the withdrawal procedure.

A student will be determined to be withdrawn from USHR if the student misses seven (7) consecutive instructional days and all of the days are unexcused.

All refunds will be submitted within 45 calendar days of the determination of the withdrawal date.

Leave of Absence

Students are expected to attend classes regularly in order to complete their program in a timely manner, but should a student be unable to attend for the duration of a month or more, the student should request a leave of absence.

The reasons for which a leave of absence may be approved include:

- Personal and/or family medical issues
- Death in the immediate family
- Vacation
- Other mitigating circumstances

In order to request a leave of absence, students should submit their request in writing stating the duration of their leave as well as the reason and expected return date. The contract period will be extended by the same amount of calendar days taken in the leave of absence. They also must have written consent from the administrator approving the leave. Upon return, the Enrollment Agreement Addendum will be completed and signed by all parties. Contact USHR for a Leave of Absence Form.

Grounds for Termination

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Students are to not threaten anyone in any manner i.e. physical, verbal, social media. Any threats, to any student, staff member or against school is grounds for termination. Any and all actions should contribute to a positive environment. Any behavior that does not contribute to a positive environment may be subject to disciplinary action including termination. In addition, a student can be expelled if the student fails to comply with any of USHR’s policies.

Payment Option

The student may pay their tuition according to their financial agreement. Payments may be made via cashiers check or money order. In addition, credit cards and ACH transfers may be paid through online invoicing. All tuition must be paid in full before the student can receive their certificate of graduation. The schedule in which the installments will be collected will be determined using (1) the estimated time required for the completion of the prescribed program or (2) using the time estimated by the student for the completion of the prescribed program. Payment plans are offered by the sole discretion of USHR and may require a credit check.

The school will send access to the online theoretical portion once the student has fully paid for the Certified Electrolysis Program or entered into a financial agreement with USHR.		

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Notice Concerning Transferability of Credits and Credentials Earned at USHR

The transferability of credits you earn at Utah School of Hair Removal is at the complete discretion of the institution to which you may seek to transfer. Acceptance of the certificate you earn in the 600 hour Certified Electrolysis Program is also at the complete discretion of the institution to which you may seek to transfer if the certificate that you earn in the 600 hour Certified Electrolysis Program at this USHR is not accepted at the institution to which you seek to transfer, you may be required to repeat some or all of your coursework at that institution. For this reason, you should make certain that your attendance at USHR will meet your educational goals. It may include contacting the institution to which you may seek to transfer after attending Utah School of Hair Removal to determine if your diploma will transfer.

Disputes
