Admission Requirements

- Applicants must provide valid proof of identification. (government issued photo identification)
- Applicants must be at least 17 years of age. If a student is currently enrolled in high school, transcripts with
 passing grades and parental permission is required. Prior to enrollment, USHR will seek a training agreement with
 the student's school district. Otherwise, a completed high school transcript, a high school diploma, or the
 equivalent GED is required as prescribed by Utah law. (See Rule 152-34-4 (3) of the Utah Administrative Code.
 USHR accepts a copy of a college transcript showing completion of an Associate's degree or higher in lieu of a
 GED, high school transcript or high school diploma.
- Applicants must fill out the Enrollment Agreement, Disclosure Statement, Distance Education Self Assessment Form, and pay a non-refundable \$100.00 Application Fee. Once applicants are accepted into USHR, a deposit of \$1500 must be paid to hold their spot in desired practical training (hands-on) semester.
- Applicants must have a good working knowledge of English, both reading and writing.
- Applicants with a foreign high school diploma: the translation and evaluation of the credential must be performed by an outside agency that is qualified to translate documents into English and confirm the academic equivalence to a U.S. high school diploma.
- Students who were previously enrolled but have withdrawn from the program can re-enroll based on administrative approval. Applicants must start the enrollment process over and pay all associated fees applied to a new applicant.

Graduation Requirements

In order to be considered for graduation, students completing the Certified Electrolysis Program must successfully complete the following:

- Attain 600 or more clock hours and satisfy the minimum hours required.
- Successfully pass all quizzes and exams with a score of 75% or more.
- Successfully pass the written final exam and practical final exam with a 75% or more.
- Attain 250 theoretical hours and 350 practical hours.
- Must have all financial obligations to Utah School of Hair Removal (may be referred to as USHR or school going forward) met, unless a financial agreement has been made.

Students will be provided with a "Certificate of Completion" and "Verification of Graduation" which will enable them to take the Utah State Board exams.

Payment Option

The student may pay their tuition according to their financial agreement. Payments may be made via cashiers check or money order. In addition, credit cards and ACH transfers may be paid through online invoicing. All tuition must be paid in full before the student can receive their certificate of graduation. The schedule in which the installments will be collected will be determined using (1) the estimated time required for the completion of the prescribed program or (2) using the time estimated by the student for the completion of the prescribed program. Payment plans are offered by the sole discretion of USHR and may require a credit check.

Federal Student Loan Debt

Students at the Utah School of Hair Removal are not currently eligible for federal student loans. At this time, USHR does not meet the U.S. Department of Education criteria that would allow its students to participate in federal student aid programs.

Cancellation and Refund Policy Student's Right to Cancel:

The student has the right to cancel and obtain a full refund of charges paid until midnight of the third business day after the latest of the following days. Official cancellation or withdrawal shall occur on the earlier of the dates that:

- 1. The day the student signs an enrollment agreement;
- 2. The day the student pays USHR and initial deposit or first payment toward tuition and fees; or
- 3. The day that the student first visits USHR and before the student receives access to the online theoretical portion.

For applicants who cancel enrollment or students who withdraw from enrollment, a fair and equitable settlement will apply. The following policy will apply to all terminations for any reason, by either party, including student decision, program cancellation, or school closure.

^{*}Additional charges may be incurred if the program is not completed on-time.

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The refund excludes the \$100.00 non-refundable Application Fee and, if received, the Business Starter Kit including tax. The notice of cancellation shall be in writing and submitted directly to Utah School of Hair Removal.

Students beginning the distance education portion of their training shall have the right to cancel the agreement and receive a full refund before the first lesson and material are requested. Cancellations are effective on the date the written notice of cancellation is sent. If the student has received any materials, not including Business Starter Kit, before an effective cancellation notice was received, USHR shall make a refund within 45 calendar days after the cancellation.

Other Cancellations: An application requesting cancellation more than three (3) days after executing the enrollment agreement and making an initial payment, but prior to beginning the distance education/online theoretical portion is entitled to a refund of all monies paid, less a maximum tuition fee of 15% of the state cost of the program.

Withdrawal Procedure

A student choosing to withdraw from the school after the commencement of classes is to provide a written notice to the school. The notice must include the expected last date of attendance and be signed and dated by the student.

If special circumstances arise, a student may request, in writing, a leave of absence, which should include the date the student anticipates the leave beginning and ending. The withdrawal date will be the date the student is scheduled to return from a leave of absence but fails to do so.

A student will be determined to be withdrawn from USHR if the student misses seven (7) consecutive instructional days and all of the days are unexcused.

All refunds will be submitted within 45 calendar days of the determination of the withdrawal date.

Refund Policy

After the cancellation period, USHR provides a pro rate refund of ALL funds paid for tuition charges to students who have completed 50 percent or less of the period of attendance. Once more than 50 percent of the enrollment period in the entire program has been incurred (including absences), there will be no refund to the student.

The application fee of \$100.00 is a non-refundable item. Business Starter Kit and any other items issued and received by the student are not returnable or refundable. Once received by the student it will belong to the student and will represent a liability to the student.

If you cancel the agreement, the school will refund any money that you paid, less any deduction for Application Fee and equipment received. If you withdraw from school after the cancellation period, the refund policy will apply. If the amount that you have paid is more than the amount that you owe for the time you attended, then a refund will be made within 45 calendar days of the official withdrawal. See Refunds section below. If the amount that you owe is more than the amount that you have already paid, then you will have to arrange to pay it. The official withdrawal date is on the student's notification or school's determination.
